



SedonaWeb 1.0 Customization:

In SedonaWeb 1.0, customers can change the logo/header and footer information as well as add a welcome/login message.

The bulk of this will be handled by files in the SedonaWeb/Customizable folder. Typically this will be C:\inetpub\SedonaWeb#.##.##\Customizable (where # is the SedonaWeb version the customer is on):

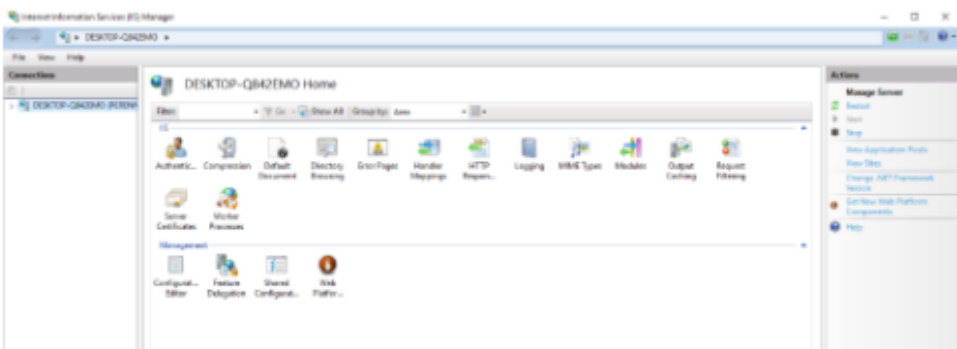

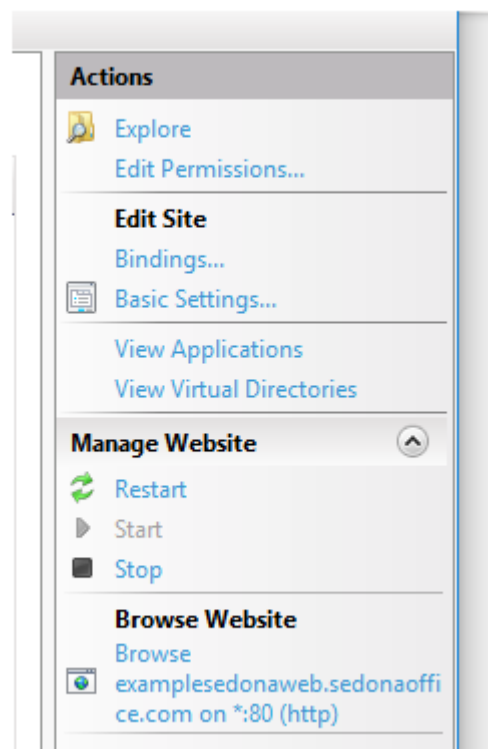
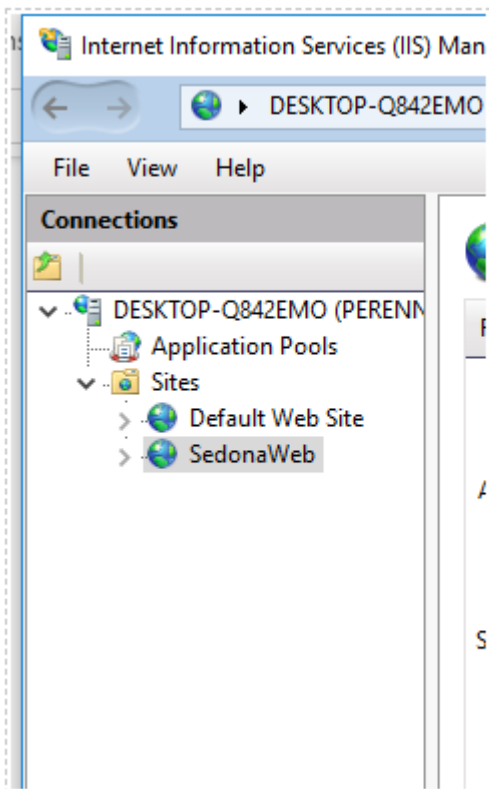
Finding Customizable Folder (Non-standard/multiple SW folders):

Go to Start > type "IIS" > you should see "Internet Information Services (IIS) Manager". Open that.

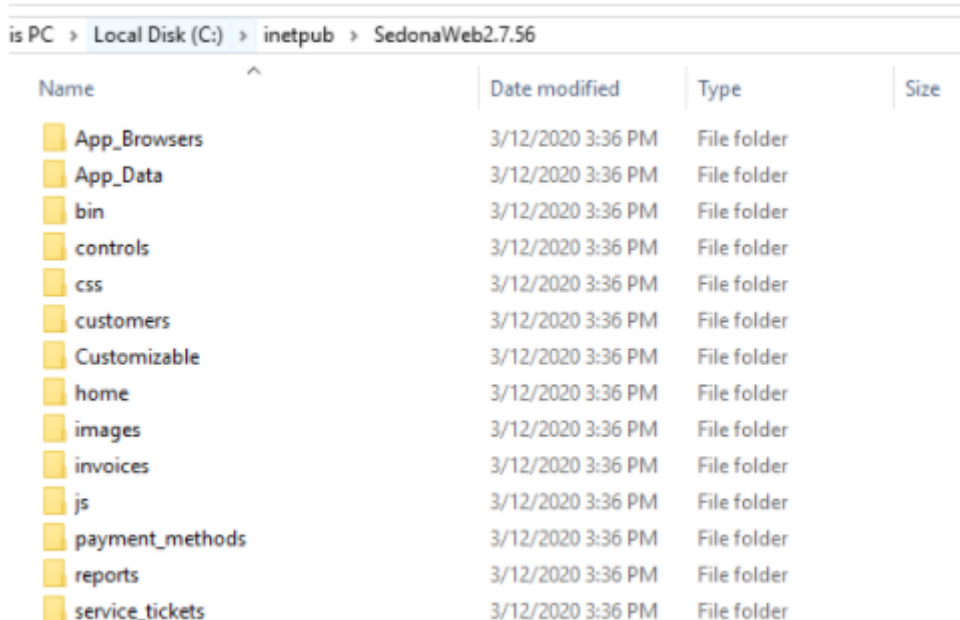


Expand the tree on the left and locate and select the site for SedonaWeb. There m

Expand the tree on the left and locate and select the site for SedonaWeb. There may be multiple, the customer should be able to identify by the URL (Under "Browse Website" on the right once selected):



Click on Explore on the top right once you have the SedonaWeb site selected:



Voila! There's your customizable folder.


Changing the Logo:

As with the logo, there are two files we need to change here, one for pre-login and one for after the customer has logged in:

Footer.ascx

Outside_footer.ascx

Again these files should look similar in terms of content. Just edit one with the new address info in place of ours and copy the contents of the file to the other:

Editing SedonaWeb Header Text (or removing it):

Toward the bottom of the company_logo/outside_header files from earlier you should see these two lines:

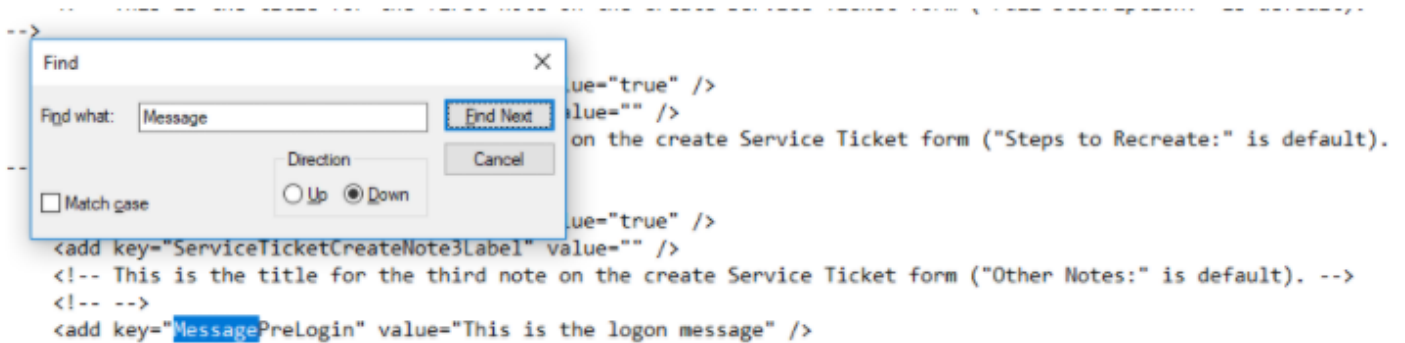
You can change the Text="Sedona" and Text="Web" parts to have the desired text in the quotes or delete everything in the quotes to remove the text.

For this one we need to journey outside the Customizable folder and to the web.config file located in the base SedonaWeb folder:

Once you open this in notepad, you'll want to do a CTRL+F to search for "Message". This should bring you to a line like this:



This line and the following "MessageWelcome" line control the pre-login and post-login messages respectively. Just put the desired message in the quotes after "Value=" on the proper line.
