New & Improved SedonaWeb 2.0 Registration Process

- We've made the SedonaWeb 2.0 registration process much, much easier for your customers with this release. Now your customers will use a registration code to create a new SedonaWeb 2.0 account, and you can generate this code from the SedonaOffice Customer Setup screen. The registration code has also been added to invoice templates.

Void EFT Transactions in Customer Record

- Now you can void EFT transactions in a customer's EFT history within the Customer Record. This enhancement has been requested by many of our customers, and it puts more functionality at your fingertips within the Customer Record.

Other Improvements & Maintenance

- Add or update email addresses attached to a customer's billing information without encountering an error.
- Customer Activity Ledger now matches balance due.
- Ability to edit cycle invoices without disrupting the deferred revenue tied to the invoice.

Sedona-X Mobile 1.6.2

Documents Functionality Expanded for SedonaOffice Users in Sedona-X Mobile

- Documents added to service tickets in SedonaOffice are now visible on service tickets in the mobile app. Customer, site, and system document levels have also been added.
- When adding a document to a service ticket or job within the mobile app, you can now specify which document level it should be added to: customer, site, system, or service ticket. This document will also be available in SedonaOffice.

Upcoming Appointments Widget

- We've brought more flexibility to the Upcoming Appointments Widget with this release. Now you can configure the widget to display the number of days you want to see.

More Information When Viewing, Adding, or Editing Parts in a Service Ticket or Job

- When adding parts to a service ticket or job, you can now see the price of a part and part quantity on hand, giving you comprehensive information where you need it most in the app.
- You will also see a field for "Warehouse" when viewing, adding or editing parts in a service ticket or job.

Other Improvements & Maintenance

- Service ticket resolution is now working correctly and no longer defaulting to the system service level.
- Pictures taken in the mobile app can now be saved easily without editing document field type.
- Warehouse field has been added to parts.
- Panel type has been added as a field on service tickets.

To use these new features, make sure you've upgraded to SedonaAPI version 1.42.0.

Inventory Accounting Updated to Support True Average Costing Method

- This has been a top customer request: to simplify inventory accounting by aligning inventory tracking with the average costing method. This release updates the way AlarmBiller tracks parts received into the warehouse, calculates physical inventory adjustments, and transfers parts between warehouses, among other things, to support the average inventory costing method.

Improvements & Maintenance

- **Item and Parts** can now be reordered within the grid.
- **Sales Automation exports** updated so you can export full dataset and not only the first page of results or current page view.
