

Permission to Check which Users are Online

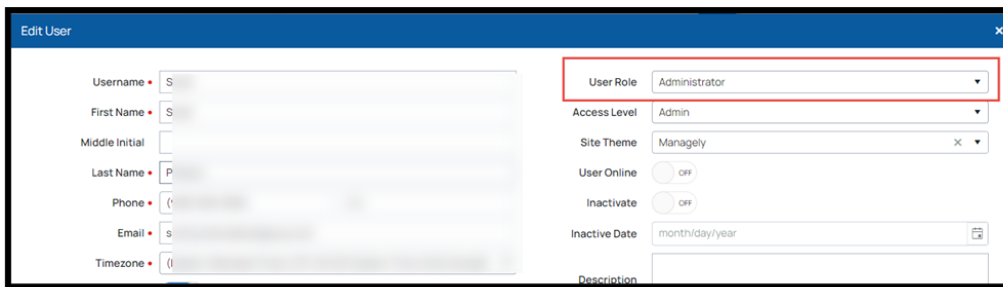
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Managely provides users with the necessary access (Administrators or User Administration permission) the ability to see if or who is currently logged into the software.

The necessary permission to be able to see if users are logged into Managely are:

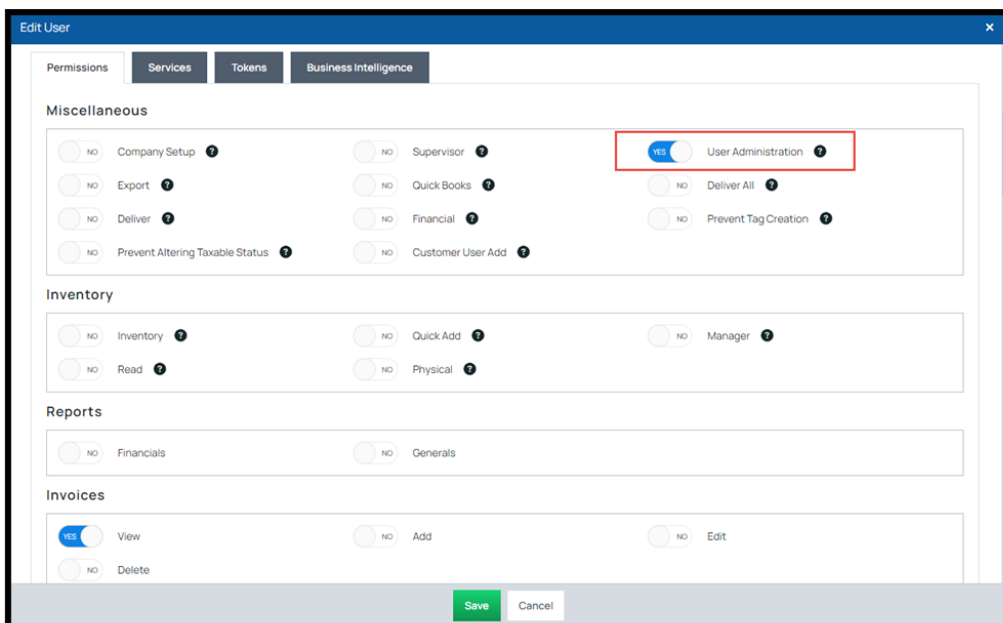
1. Administrator – This user role enables everything access related in Managely:
