

How to Find the Size of a SedonaOffice Database

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Issue:

Is there an easy way to determine the size of the database file on the SQL server?

Resolution:

The size of a SQL database can be seen by using a stored procedure.

Open the SQL Query Window inside of the SedonaOffice application.



Type in the command `// exec sp_spaceused` and hit enter or the green execute button



The results will show the database name and the disk space used by the database.

database_name	database_size	unallocated space
MasterSetupStandard	9271.25 MB	185.10 MB

This can also be run from a query window in SQL Server Management Studio.
