

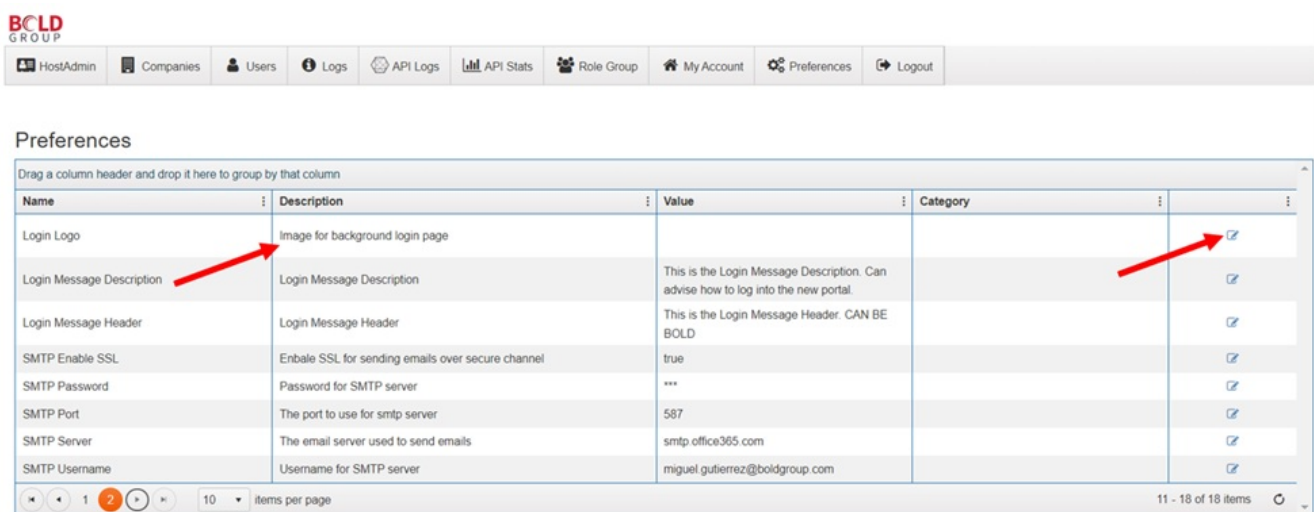
How to update Sedona Web 2.0 landing page background
